# **Annual General Meeting**

This was held in Marlborough on the 16 & 17th May including three very interesting farm visits. The first was to the Pattie family farm just south of Seddon, one of the driest areas in Marlborough. Stock were in great condition as can be seen in the photos. Herd sires on this farm are often sourced from Haywards Oakview Stud in the Waikato. The Pattie family started breeding Murray Greys in the early 1970s. Next on the farm visit was to Amanda and Simon Tripe at Koromiko, near Picton. Dairy farming is their main activity with the family farming on the property for over 100 years. They have now become involved in breeding Murray Greys and started their stud with cows purchased from Torrisdale. They have also taken to showing their Murray Greys with success in both Canterbury and Marlborough.

The third farm we visited was Leov's in the Wairau Valley (another very dry area of Marlborough). They are also new young breeders with plenty of enthusiasm for the breed. Their original stock was sourced from Sea Spring and Kourawhero Studs. Since then they have added Torrisdale, Waimak and Chequers bloodlines to their herds. I would like to thank the three breeders for allowing us to visit their properties. It's really great to see how well Murray Greys do in all climate conditions. Thank you.
