meeting . . .

Murray Grey National Sale at Beef Expo

The Council decided at its last meeting that the champion Murray Grey would be chosen from all the Murray Grey entrants at the National Sale. However only the top placed rising 2 year old bull would go forward to represent the breed in the Champion of Champions as this is a Beef Expo rule. Those members who intend or are interested in entering an animal in the National Sale should notify Lindy at the PBB office. It would be good to see our breed represented at this showcase of NZ breeds.

Formal entry forms will be sent out in the next newsletter.

Entries are open to Rising 2yr old bulls, Rising Yearling Bulls and Rising 2 year old heifers.

Beef Expo 2011 to be held at Manfeild Arena, Feilding

It is planned that Beef Expo 2011 is planned to operate along similar lines to that in 2010. The option of selling bulls by video or still photos is also being considered. A number of areas in the organising have been identified as requiring improvement following feedback from participants.

Steak of Origin 2011

Dairy Index

Council members are to review the work already done on the establishment of the Index with a view to identifying the most appropriate weighting of performance and financial data.

100% Murray Grey

Discussions are currently underway to have A grade cattle in the New Zealand data base identified as being 100% Murray Grey, see the article in Progress for a further explanation.

Changes to By Laws

The Bylaws have been changed to require confirmation that imported Sires and Angus cattle used for Grading up are clear of the recently identified genetic calf defects. Due to the advent of electronic tagging it has been decided that the rules for tattooing stock be deleted and replaced by the identification of individuals by NAIT electronic tags.

The time table for entries is as follows, closing date end of month when taken. Send to Lindy at PBB via email or post.


Cow and Calf photos taken January 2011
