Greetings to you all.

I have just been in this task for a few months now. We have good robust council meetings and we have good debate on issues that face US.

We have included in this newsletter material that was sent to Australian Members from the Australian Murray Grey Society in the spring. These are issues that we have to face up to and because Australia is our genetic source we need to be similar or fairly similar with our rules and by-laws. At present it would be possible to have a registered Pure breed in Australia but the same animal would not be regarded as Pure breed according to our rules. We need to look closely at this and would welcome comment to your local councillors.

The other area they have made a decision on is the DNA testing and CA testing (Fawn Calf). From 1st July 2013 it will be compulsory in Australia and progeny will not be registered if this hasn't taken place.

I know that DNA testing is compulsory for some other breeds in NZ before calves can be registered. While this is a cost it will help hugely down the track and Fawn Calf will be stopped before spreading to every herd. Please take time to read it thoroughly and please feel free to discuss these issues with a councillor.

PBB, our service provider, are looking at a new service agreement. We are just one of many breeds that use this service.

I trust you will all enjoy this special Christmas season with family, children, grandchildren and friends and may the New Year bring many more blessings.

DNA SAMPLES

PREFERRED SAMPLE TYPE

Hair sample for DNA and CA testing. Pluck long coarse hair from lower part of the tail. The follicles on the end should be of good length. 25 follicles (bulb intact) are needed to ensure adequate volume of DNA to complete the test.

BEEF EXPO 2013

Following the 2012 Beef Expo a "think tank" was held to brainstorm ideas to grow Beef Expo into a must attend event. Four subcommittees were formed and charged with looking at
