News from the Council....

Dairy Index

The Dairy Index is now operational and can be accessed through the website. It is added to the list of EBVs for each animal. Note that it is not recommended to use this index for selection purposes. It is to help Dairy farm customers select the most suitable bull for their purposes.

Birth Defects

The possible presence of three birth defects is a concern that needs to be noted by all breeders. These defects can be expected to be present at very low levels in Murray Greys, due to the use of Angus genetics in their background. They are Arthrogryposis Multiplex (AM), Neuropathic Hydrocephalus (NH) and Contractural Arachnodactyly (CA). A major concern is that imported semen used over a large number of cows could very quickly spread such problems within the breed. The Council recently changed the Society's Bylaws to ensure that bulls and semen being imported are free of these defects. The same requirement applies to donors of embryos.


Tests are now available should members suspect they have any of these defects present. All the three defects are recessive and carriers therefore go undetected unless the individual animal is tested. Two of the defects result in dead calves; the third, C.A.

(Fawn Calf) results in live calves which are poorly muscled and have extended limbs.

Details regarding the appearance and effects of these three genetic conditions can be found on line and the NZ Angus website has a good page relating to defects in Angus and Angus derived cattle on their Genetics page.

Contact the PBB office if you suspect you have an animal with a problem, they can direct you to an agency to have the appropriate testing done.

The Australian Society has recently done a limited amount of testing upon which they have adopted a programme to identify the status of individual animals or the likelihood that they are carriers.
